

Target Pacing Dates

With the new, streamlined student course path view, your students now have the opportunity to see target pacing dates. Target dates can help students stay on track with their courses by giving them enhanced visibility of pacing. This level of visibility of pacing also gives students more agency over their educational experience.

Note: Course sections must have end dates for target dates to be available.

Where can I see Target Pacing Dates?

Target pacing dates are available on multiple pages in your Instructor account, including:

- Section Details
- Section Curriculum
- Student Curriculum Details (pictured)


Note: If you don't see target dates, the account administrator has disabled this feature.

Do target dates change?

Yes, there are some course or account changes that may recalculate students' target dates, including:

- Editing the start or end date.
- Omitting or including an activity.
- Adjusting the Pacing Calendar.
- Reordering curriculum on the Section Curriculum page.

Students completing activities early does **not** recalculate target dates.






